

Scholarship Application Returning Recipients

The Maricopa Community Foundation (MCF) established a college scholarship fund for returning scholarship recipients residing in the City of Maricopa.

Scholarships will be based on the following:

- Application essays,
- Financial need,
- College transcripts.

In order to be eligible to apply, applicants must reside in the City of Maricopa. In addition, the applicant must be:

- Attending a junior college or university.
- Attending a vocational, technological, or health-related program.

Applicants must:

- Complete the scholarship application. (Additional pages acceptable)
- Submit official information on college GPA (a minimum **GPA of 2.5** is required).
- Proof of enrollment for the Fall semester is required in order to disburse scholarship funds, if selected, and will be requested at a later date.
- Request latest college transcripts to be sent directly to Maricopa Community Foundation.
- Incomplete or late application packets will not be considered.

Scholarships will be directly deposited into an account in recipient's name at the educational institution of attendance. Recipients will need to provide the name of the institution once enrollment is completed.

Returning applicants must submit all information by April $1^{\rm st}$

Arizona Legislative HB2008 (outlined in Arizona Revised Statutes 1-501, 1-502) states:

Notwithstanding any other state law and to the extent permitted by federal law, any natural person who applies for a federal public benefit that is administered by this state or political subdivision of this state and that requires participants to be citizens of the United States, legal residents of the United States or otherwise lawfully present in the United States shall submit at least one of the twelve documents to the entity that administers the federal public benefit demonstrating lawful presence in the United States.

In order to comply with HB2008, most Arizona state schools are requiring that you provide one of the documents listed below:

- An Arizona Driver's license issued after 1996 or an Arizona non-operating identification license
- A birth certificate or delayed birth certificate issued in any state, territory or possession of the United States
- A United States certificate of birth abroad
- A foreign passport with a United States visa
- An I-94 form with a photograph
- A United States Citizenship and Immigration Services employment authorization or refugee travel document
- A United States certificate of naturalization
- A United States certificate of citizenship
- A tribal certificate of Indian blood
- A tribal or Bureau of Indian Affairs affidavit of birth
- Tribal members, the elderly and "persons with disabilities or incapacity of the mind or body," may submit certain types of documentation under Section 1903 of the federal Social Security Act
